Electronic Sources

Academic Search Premier

A full-text, multidisciplinary magazine & journal database that provides the full text of over 4,500 journals and magazines, and indexes a total of more than 8,000 titles in all disciplines.

LexisNexis™ News 1980s+

Full text for most materials, including newspapers, magazines, news wires and transcripts. Good coverage of international news, but includes only a few academic research journals.

PsycINFO 1872+

References to and summaries of journal articles in the international psychology and behavioral science literature and the related fields of education, business, medicine, and law. Beginning with 1987, also provides references to and summaries for books and book chapters: updated weekly.

Web of Science 1994+

Multidisciplinary bibliographic database that indexes and abstracts journals in the sciences, social sciences, arts, and humanities. Distributed by the Institute for Scientific Information, *Web of Science* is a cumulation of three databases: *Science Citation Index (SCI)*, *Social Sciences Citation Index (SSCI)*, and *Arts and Humanities Citation Index (A&HCI)*.

Academic OneFile 1980+

Provides nearly 3,000 full text articles from journals with good coverage of the social sciences. Includes indexing for major newspapers.
