# Introduction

Microform Collections are located on Level 3 North of the Babbidge Library. These collections include the following formats: microfilm, microfiche, and microprint. Microform collections are arranged by format then alphabetically by collection title in the Microform Collection cabinets. The microprint collection is housed with the microfiche collection.

Guides and indexes to Microform Collections are located on top of the microfilm cabinets. All guides are shelved alphabetically by collection title.

Note: Babbidge Microform Collections are research materials that do not circulate.

• **Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station New Haven**

Scope: Authorized by the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut in 1875, the Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station in New Haven investigates plants and their pests, insects, soil and water; analyzes food, pesticides, fertilizers and other products; conducts research in appropriate areas and reports findings through publications. This collection includes *Annual Reports* and *Bulletins* from 1877-1969 as well as *Circulars*, *Frontiers of Plant Science*, and *General Publications* for some of those years.
