Introduction

Microform Collections are located on Level B of the Babbidge Library. These collections consist of microfilm and microfiche. They are grouped by format and arranged alphabetically by collection title in the microform cabinets. Microform collections are research materials that **do not circulate**.

Guides and indexes are available to some of these microform collections either electronically or are physically located on top of the cabinets. All physical guides are shelved alphabetically by collection.

Pamphlets and Leaflets of the Social Democratic Federation and the British Socialist Party (BSP) 1883-1931

- Scope: Founded as the Democratic Federation (DF) in 1881, the organization became the Social Democratic Federation in 1884. During its history, the party was subject to a number of splits and mergers. SDF focused on providing a political voice for the British working class. 1883-1931.
- Format: Microfiche (173 fiche)
- Arrangement: Chronological except for bound volume of additional pamphlets in appendix.
- Indexes: Chronological listings of pamphlets on Fiche 1 and Fiche 2 of collection.

Pamphlets and Leaflets of the Independent Labour Party (ILP) 1893-1975 (Archives of the Independent Labour Party)

- Scope: The ILP was founded in 1893 by labor and socialist organizations to promote direct labor representation in Parliament. In 1900, the ILP helped create the Labour Representation Committee which became the Labour party. The microfiche collection encompasses the many pamphlets and leaflets published by the ILP that highlight the evolution of labor thought and reveal the issues the ILP addressed, for example: Unemployment, trade unions, strikes, child labor, women's suffrage, poverty, and conscription. 1893-1975.
