







The EAST retention model and corpus


Retention rules:

- 1. Retain ALL existing holdings for titles that are scarcely held
- 2. Retain up to FIVE holdings for titles with significant use across the EAST membership
- 3. Retain ONE holding for all titles that fall outside of the above criteria
- 4. Exclude from the corpus:
 - a. Items published in 2011 or later
 - b. Ephemera


